



# WeTogether Scholarship Guidelines

WeTogether is a non-profit organization that initially started in 2005 to support those in imprisonment and their families. Since 2011, WeTogether has been serving people around the Jane and Finch area who are in need of love, care, and financial support.

The goal of the WeTogether Scholarship program is for post-secondary students who are enrolled in Canadian Universities or Colleges, and to assist the next generation of Jane and Finch area community leaders with financial support during their academic year. It is available for all post-secondary students who meet our program eligibilities regardless of race or religions. The program supports 5-7 students annually with \$1,500 per student.

## Required application documents

1. Application Form for the WeTogether Scholarship, fully completed and signed
2. Essay (1000 words or less)

Your essay should include but not limited to:

a) Life story of yourself in the past and present- information about yourself and your life which says something significant about you and how you have come to be who you are focusing on a few key events, relationships and themes throughout your childhood and youth

b) Life story of your future - what goals/aspiration and dreams you like to accomplish or realize in the future and the plans or ideas to achieve those, and in your future how you can positively influence the community that you are living in.

3. Proof of full-time registration
4. Unofficial Transcripts - the most recent two semesters
5. Two reference letters, including at least one from professors or course instructors
6. The deadline for applications is Sunday, October 01, 2023.

Applicants selected as finalists will be notified by October 16, 2023, and interviewed by a selection panel on October 20, 2023. Scholarships will be awarded in November 2023.

## Eligibility

- Post-Secondary Full-time Students who currently enrolled in Canadian Universities or Colleges with minimum average of 70% or B-
- Age between 18 and 35 inclusive - driver's license or phone bill to be brought for the interview
- Place of Residence within Jane & Finch area - M9L, M9M, M3J, M3K, M3L, M3M and M3N using FSA (first 3 digits of the postal code) - driver's license or phone bill to be brought for the interview
